Dear Bryan:

I am writing to inform you that you were recently identified as being present at an incident that occurred in the Burdett Avenue Residence Hall (BARH) on October 2, 2017. Specifically it was reported that you were among a group of students that gained access to BARH and were distributing fliers without the authorization from the Office of Student Living and Learning.

I am not referring this matter to the judicial process, however I did want to take a moment to remind you that you have a responsibility to understand and comply with all Institute policies, including the following:

- 1. Any individual who desires to enter a residence hall who does not live in said hall must be (a) hosted by a current resident of the residence hall they are visiting or (b) receive authorization from the Office of Student Living and Learning.
- 2. Students and other guests must receive prior authorization from the Office of Student Living and Learning to post or distribute information in a residence hall.
